SUPPORTIVE HOUSING WORKER**

Bridge to Housing as a new CMHA housing project that will provide temporary housing for up to 40 adults in Kamloops who are currently homeless. This project will provide all aspects of housing in a communal environment. There will be 3 meals a day provided, as well as life skills programming, volunteer opportunities, healthcare, counselling and other supports on site. The staff will work collaboratively with tenants, service providers, our neighbours and other community members to create a safe and supportive atmosphere.

Duration of Position: Start date week of November 5, 2018; position end date TBD (estimated late spring 2019).

Position Types: Full time, part time and casual.

Hours of Work: 7am-3pm; 3pm-11pm; 11pm-7am.

Qualifications: Degree in social services or a Diploma in Human/Social Service, or a combination of education, training and experience.
