**INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL JOB POSTING – “Wildfire Recovery”
Outreach and Navigation worker**

This new Outreach and Navigation worker position is a temporary position to provide services and supports to individuals and families impacted by the wildfires in the Cache Creek and Ashcroft region. This role works in community, connecting with individuals that need immediate support and navigation into longer term services.

Duration of Position: Start date immediately. Position currently ends in the fall of 2019, with the possibility of an extension.

Position Type: Part time.

Hours of Work: To be set in consultation with successful applicant, but typically daytime hours between Monday and Friday with flexibility to work some evenings and weekends. **Total hours per week to start is 25.** Scheduled shifts may change as the needs of the organization change with no less than 2 weeks’ notice and in accordance with Employment Standards Act of British Columbia.

Qualifications: Degree in social services or a Diploma in Human/Social Service, or a combination of education, training and experience.
Current level 1 First Aid required.

Location of Work: Ashcroft Hub and surrounding area.

Probation: 3 months from start date.

Salary: \$20.50 to \$23.50 per hour commensurate with experience.

Benefits: Paid sick time will accrue at a rate of 6.9% of time worked and will payable during approved sick leave only. Benefits will include extended health, dental, group life, accidental death & dismemberment and MSP. Benefits are available at the completion of probation.
